

Agriculture Lease.

These Leases, made and entered into this 16th day of March 1901, by and between Aggie Fickel and Couron, Fickel & Fickel, Oklahoma, hereinafter called the lessors, and Mrs. Bridges, of Shickel, Oklahoma, hereinafter called the lessee, witnesseth.

1. That the lessors have the following described land, situate and situate in Pottawatomie County, Oklahoma, to-wit: the southeast quarter (SE 1/4) of N. 27 1/2 of section 8, N. 27 1/2 of T. 40 S., R. 23 E., M. 6 E., and in section 18, township 19 north, range 11 east, N. 6 E., M. 6 E. of section 7 township 19 north, range 11 east.

2. That the lessors, in consideration of the sum of money, and agreement therein contained and expressed, hereby rent lease and let to the lessee the above described premises, to have and to hold the same from the 1st day of March 1901 to the 1st day of March 1902, together with the stockage, and improvements thereon, for agricultural purposes, and in full payment to place the lease in the quiet and peaceable possession of said premises.

3. That the lessee covenants to place the lease in the quiet and peaceable possession of said premises on or before the beginning of the term covered by this lease, and to protect the lease in the quiet and peaceable possession of said premises during the term of this lease.

4. That the lessors, promised and agreed to pay to the lessee, as rental for said premises for said term, the sum of three (\$3.00) dollars, for and for said premises, to be paid by the lessee, all want to be paid in the 1st day of January of each year in advance during the term of this lease.

5. That if said lessee want money while the term of this lease, shall have the same placed in the quiet and actual possession of said premises.

6. That the lease, in it have the postage of all land, notice, and the lease of all buildings, and one said premises.
