Agricultural Lease.

This lease, made and entered into this 16th day of March 1908, by and between Cepharney Ficker, a single man of Ficker, Oklahoma, hereafter called the lessor, and W.M. Bridger of Ficker, Oklahoma, hereafter called the lessee, with intent

1. That the lessor own the following described real estate and premises, situated in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to-wit:

That the lessor, in consideration of the several promises, and agreements herein contained, and expressed, hereby rents, leases and lets to the lessee the above described premises, to have and to hold the same from the 9th day of March, 1909 to the 9th day of March 1912, together with the buildings and improvements thereon, for agricultural purposes.
