Now on motion of Martin Price, attorney for executor, it is ordered and adjudged that the petition be and hereby is granted and the seal and the return of the proceedings thereof and the said order be and are hereby in all things approved and confirmed, and the clerk of this court is ordered and directed to make an entry on the journal of this court that the Court is satisfied with the legality of this call and said clerk is ordered to record a certified copy of this order in the office of the register of deeds in the County of Tucker, Alabama.

It is further ordered that the executor make, execute and deliver to the said purchaser a good and sufficient deed of conveyance to the party so sold conveying all of the rights, title and interest of the said decedent in and to said property at the time of his death.)
