Power of Attorney

Know all Men, By These Presents,

That Richard Coon, of Oklahoma, have made, constituted, and appointed, and by these presents do make, constitute and appoint, James D. Webb, of Oklahoma, my true and lawful attorney, for me, and in my name, place and stead, and to my use, doest or leave for procuring or agricultural purposes, the West 1/2 of the NE 1/4 of section 5, Township 21 range 13 East of the Indian Meridian; to collect all rents and trouble accruing there from and to exercise a general supervision thereover and to take the possession thereof at any time I might otherwise state such possession myself giving my said attorney full power to do everything whatsoever, requisite and necessary to be done in the premises as fully as though I were personally present, with full power of substitution and revocation, hereby ratifying and confirming all that my said attorney, or his substitute, shall lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue hereof.
