ASSIGNMENT OF OIL AND GAS LEASE

WHEREAS, The Secretary of the Interior has here-
tofore approved an oil and gas mining lease, dated May 5th.

said lease is now owned by Waite Phillips Company, and Fred A. Stubbs.

and interest of the lessee in and to said lease, subject to the approval of the Secretary
of the Interior to Phillips Petroleum Company of Bartlesville, Oklahoma, said assignment
to be effective from date of approval hereof by the Secretary of the Interior.
