CONTRACT FOR SALE OF LAND.

THIS AGREEMENT, Made and entered into this 14th, day of April, 1923 at Tulsa, Oklahoma by and between W.H Yeakley party of the first part, and W. R. Henry, party of the second part.

WITNESSETH: That said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Twenty Dollars, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does for himself, his heirs and assigns hereby agree to sell and convey by good and sufficient deed of general warranty, wife joining unto the said second party, his heirs and assigns, the following described real estate situated in the city of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, to-wit: Lot Twelve (12) in Block one (1) Inghram-Lewis Addition to the city of Tulsa, Oklahoma, according to the recorded plat thereof, together with all the improvements and appurtenances thereon, free and clear of all incumbrances of every kind or nature.

Said first party is to give possession of said premises at once to the said second party. And to pay the taxes for the year 1922, all further and future taxes and any assessments for improvements is to be paid by the second party.

said second party is to pay for said property the sum of One thousand (\$1,000.00)
