KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

WHEREAS a certain oil and gas mining lease, dated the 7th day of August, 1908, was given by Jennie Bruner, a full blood citizen of the Creek Nation, enrolled opposite Roll No. 5814, lessor, to W. A. Springer and E. R. Minshall, lessees, covering, among other lands, the following described real estate and premises, situate in Tulsa county, in the State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 6, Township 19 North, Range 12 East of the Indian Meridian, and containing forty acres more or less,

and

WHEREAS said oil and gas lease was approved by the Honorable, the Secretary of the Interior, on the 14th day of September, 1908, and

WHEREAS said oil and gas mining lease was afterward assigned by said lessees to the Mary Oil & Gas Company, a corporation, organized and existing under the laws of the State of Oklahoma, and

WHEREAS such assignment was duly approved by the Honorable, the Secretary of the Interior, on the 25th day of May, 1912, said lease and all right thereunder, so far as same covers the real estate and premises, above described, being now owned by said Mary Oil & Gas Company, and

WHEREAS William G. Bruner and Esther Bruner; and Willima G. Bruner as the guardian of Stella Bruner, a minor, heirs at law of said Jennie Bruner, deceased, have executed leases respectively to the Sand Springs Home, a corporation, incorporated and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Oklahoma, and such leases being dated November 27th, 1922, and which have been submitted to the Department with Application for Approval, and

WHEREAS it is the desire of the Mary Oil & Gas Company, a corporation, to release the oil and gas lease hereinabove described, provided the leases given to the sand springs Home, above described, shall be approved by the Secretary of the Interior. (Mar. 14, 1923)  
NATIONAL SECURITY CO. BOND NOT HELD Lease forwarded to Dept. recommending cancellation  
NOW THEREFORE, these presents witness that the Mary Oil & Gas Company, a corporation, does hereby cancel, release, relinquish and surrender all of its right, title and interest in and to the said oil and gas mining lease in so far as it covers the lands above described; Provided, however, that this release shall be effective only upon the approval by the Secretary of the Interior of the leases above described, given by William G. Bruner and Esther Bruner; and William G. Bruner, guardian of Stella Bruner, a minor, to Sand springs Home, a corporation, dated the 27th day of November, 1922.
