Whereas, JESSIE L. BERGE a citizen of the CHEROKEE Nation, was allotted certain land, which land is restricted against alienation.

Now, Therefore, I, under the authority vested in me by the Act of Congress approved May 27, 1908 (35 Stat. L., 512), and the regulations of the Department prescribed thereunder, hereby remove, without conditions concerning terms of sale and disposal of proceeds, the restrictions on alienation of all the restricted lands of said Indian allottee, such removal of restrictions to be effective thirty days from date hereof.
