MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT, Made and entered into in triplicate, this the 3rd day of Oct. 1918, by and between REYNOLDS OIL & GAS COMPANY, a corporation, party of the first part, and ATLANTIC PETROLEUM CORPORATION, a corporation, Tulsa, Oklahoma, party of the second part,

WITNESSETH: That,

WHEREAS, on the 21st day of March, 1918, party of the first part made, executed and delivered to the party of the second part an agreement in writing, whereby party of the first part agreed to sell and party of the second part agreed to purchase, the casinghead gas produced from wells located on the following described land in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to-wit:

The Northeast quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 34, Township 17 North, Range 14 East,
