Whereas, GEORGE B. PERRYMAN a citizen of the Creek Nation, was allotted the following described land, to-wit:

A tract of land five hundred (500) feet square in the Northeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Northwest quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Nineteen (19), Township Nineteen (19) north, Range Thirteen (13) east of the Indian Base and Meridian, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the northeast corner of the Northwest quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) thence west Five hundred (500) feet; thence south Five hundred (500) feet; thence east Five hundred (500) feet; thence north Five Hundred (500) feet to place of beginning, in Section Nineteen (19), Township Nineteen (19) north, Range Thirteen (13) east containing 5.75 acres, more or less, located in Tulsa County, Oklahoma
