RECEIPT

COMPARED

This agreement made and entered into on this 14th day of May, 1923 by and between Mildred Childers, party of the first part, and E. A. Ross, Henry N. Greisand Flesher Petroleum Company, parties of the second part;

That the party of the first part is a daughter of Roley McIntosh, who had allotted to him, as a part of his allotment the following described land in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to-wit:

The southwest quarter of the northwest quarter of Section one, Township 18 North, Range 12 east (and other lands not herein described) and

Whereas, the second parties claim to be the owners of said land, and oil and gas mining lease thereon, and the first part claims to have an interest therein as an heir of said Roley McIntosh;

And, whereas the second parties hereto have purchased all the right title and interest in said land from said first party, in consideration of the sum of Eighteen Hundred dollars.

Now, therefore the said first party does hereby acknowledge the receipt of the sum of Eighteen Hundred dollars from second parties, in full settlement of all her right, title and interest in the above described property, and hereby releases and discharges said second parties from any and all claims and demands of all character and kind whatsoever heretofore accruing to her or claimed by her on account of the use and occupation of the above described land by the parties of the second part, and by reason of all rents and royalties from oil or gas derived or to be derived from the above described premises.
