John J. Harden, of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, for and in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred and no/100 (\$300.00) DOLLARS, to me in hand paid by Mrs. H. Hirsch, the receipt of which is hereby fully acknowledged.

HAVE GRANTED, SOLD AND CONVEYED and by these presents do GRANT, SELL AND CONVEY unto the said Mrs. H. Hirsch of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land lying and being situated in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and being Lot #35 in Jewish Section, containing 300 square feet, be the same more or less out of ROSE HILL BURIAL PARK as more fully appears from map of said Burial Park hereby referred to and made a part hereof.

It is expressly agreed and understood that this conveyance is made subject to the provisions and restrictions specified in the Rules and Regulations of said Burial Park at the present time, and which are made a part of this conveyance, or which said Burial Park may hereafter make in conformity with the laws of the State of Oklahoma.

The said Grantor hereby covenants and agrees with the said grantee to set aside
