that only one residence shall be built on one lot; that no part of the lot or lots hereby conveyed shall ever be sold or rented to or occupied by any persons of African descent, commonly known as negroes, except that the building of a servants' house to be used only by the servants of the owners of the lot or lots hereby conveyed shall not be considered as a breach of the condition hereof. Any violations of the foregoing conditions and restriction by the grantee, his heirs or assigns, shall work a forfeiture to all title in and to and are hereby made obligatory upon the party of the second part his heirs and assigns, forever, together with all and singular, the heretitaments and appurtenances hereunto belonging.
