AGREEMENT

COMPARED

THIS AGREEMENT, entered into this 7th day of May 1923, by and between Liverty Oil  
 Company, Incorporated, party of the first part, and Diamond Refining Company of Tulsa, Okla-  
 homa, party of the second part.

The first party, in consideration of the covenants and agreements herein contained,  
 agrees to sell and deliver to the second party, all the casing head gases issuing and to  
 issue from the well or wells of the First Party, which may be suitable for the purpose of ex-  
 tracting therefrom gasoline or gas condensates; the wells being located on oil and gas leases  
 of the First Party, described as follows, to wit:

Lula A. Jordan Lease, covering the South Half (S $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the North East  
 Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) and the North West Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the North East Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ )  
 of Section Thirty-five (35) - Township Eighteen (18) North, Range Twelve (12)
