453 II. All and singular the mining plant, and all houses, buildings, tenements, structures, fixtures, tools, implements and machinery owned by the Southwestern Company at the date of the execution and delivery of its First Mortgage dated July 1, 1889, and situated at, or in or about the mines then owned by the Southwestern Company in Atoka County, Indian Territory, or used or employed in connection with the working thereof.

III. All and singular the following described lands situate in Cherokee County, in the State of Kansas, in township thirty-two (32) South of Range Twenty-three (23) East, to wit:

The North Half of Section Seven (7);

The North Half and the South-West Quarter of Section Eight (8);

The South half and the North-West Quarter of Section Five (5);

The North Half of Section Four (4);

The North Half of the South East Quarter and the North-East Quarter of Section Nine (9); and

The undivided seven-ninths (7/9) of the North-west Quarter of Section Nine (9).

IV. The South-west quarter of Section four (4) in township thirty-two (32) South of range Twenty-three (23) East, in Cherokee County, in the State of Kansas. Also all coal and other mineral lying and being beneath the surface of the South-east quarter of said Section Four (4) and beneath the Southwest Quarter of the south-west Quarter of section three (3), all in township thirty-two (32) South of Range Twenty-three (23), East, in Cherokee County, in the State of Kansas.

V. The leases and addition thereto held in trust for the Railway Company in the name of George T. Cutts, described as follows:

(a) The six coal mining leases made to the Southwestern Company by Napoleon B. Ainsworth and Charles D. Carter, as Mining Trustees of the Choctaw and Chickasaw Nations, dated March 20, 1902, and approved April 4, 1902, by the Secretary of the Interior, known respectively as Lease No. 1, Lease No. 2, Lease No. 3, Lease No. 4, Lease No. 5 and Lease No. 6, and covering respectively tracts of land in the State of Oklahoma, formerly within the Choctaw Nation, Indian Territory, described as follows:

Under Lease No. 1:

The East 1/2 of the Southwest 1/4 and the Southeast 1/4 of Section 26; the Southwest 1/4 and the West 1/2 of the Southeast 1/4 of Section 25; the North 1/2 of the Northwest 1/4 and the North 1/2 of the South 1/2 of the Northwest 1/4 and the North 1/2 of the Northeast 1/4 and the North 1/2 of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 35; the North 1/2 of the Northwest 1/4 and the North 1/2 of the South 1/2 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 36, all in Township One (1) North, Range Ten (10) East, of the Indian Meridian, and containing Eight hundred and forty acres more or less.

Under Lease No. 2:

The Northwest 1/4 and the Southwest 1/4 and the West 1/2 of the Northeast 1/4 and the West 1/2 of the Southeast 1/4 of Section 24; the Northwest 1/4 and the West 1/2 of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 25; the East 1/2 of the East 1/2 of the Northeast 1/4 and the East 1/2 of the Southeast 1/4 of Section 23; the East 1/2 of the Northeast 1/4 and the East 1/2 of the West 1/2 of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 26; all in Township One (1) North, Range Ten (10) East of the Indian Meridian, and containing Nine hundred and sixty acres, more or less.

Under Lease No. 3:

All of Section 13 of Township One (1) North, Range Ten (10) East, and the West 1/2 of Section 18 of Township One (1) North, Range Eleven (11) East of the Indian Meridian, containing Nine Hundred and sixty acres, more or less.
