Whereas, CAHNUNDESKI GRITTS, now Pheasant, a citizen of the CHEROKEE Nations was allotted the following described land, to-wit:

West half (W2) of Northwest Quarter (NW4) of South-east Quarter (SE4) of Section Eleven (11) Township Twenty (20) North, Range Thirteen (13) East of the Indian Base and Meridian containing 20 acres, more or less, located in Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

Now, Therefore, I, under the authority vested in me by the Act of Congress approved May 27, 1908 (Public No. 140.) and the regulations prescribed thereunder, hereby remove the restrictions from said described land such removal of restrictions to become effective only and simultaneously with the execution of the deed by said allottee to the purchaser after said land has been sold in compliance with the directions of the Secretary of the Interior.
