KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

COMPARED

THAT I, J. S. Stafford, have a claim against Tipton Petroleum Company, and Shepherd Petroleum Company, each being corporation, for the sum of \$813.50, for labor performed as follows: Pumping five oil wells from October 1st, 1921, to January 15th, 1923, being a period of fifteen months, at and for an agreed compensation of \$50.00 per month, making a total of \$775.00; pulling tubing on one well, with team and two extra hands, at and for \$14.00 for team and \$3.50 for each hand, for two days, making a total for pulling tubing of \$28.00; Pulling Rods on one well, team \$7.00 and one extra hand \$3.50 making a total for pulling rods of \$10.50 all of said labor having been performed on lease located on the following described property, to-wit:

The Southeast quarter of the Southeast Quarter
of Section 9, and the Southwest Quarter of the
Southwest Quarter of Section 10, all in township
18, North Range 13, East, Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

And that such labor was performed under contract made originally with the Tipton Petroleum Company, under the terms of which contract claimant was to receive \$50.00 per month for pumping, and the other items for pulling tubing and rods, as specified hereinbefore, said contract being with the said Tipton Petroleum Company, a corporation, made on the 1st, day of October 1921, at which time the said Tipton Petroleum Company was the owner of the leasehold estate covering the premises above described; and which said leasehold estate was by the said Tipton Petroleum Company, on the 11th day of April 1922, transferred and assigned to the Shepherd Petroleum Company, and upon the making of such transfer, the said contract, upon the same terms and conditions was continued with the said Shepherd Petroleum Company, the two corporations named having been respectively the owners of the lease and leasehold estate and also of all equipment, wells and other proportion located thereon concerned in and connected with the exploring and developing of said premises for oil and gas.

That said sum and sums claimed, is just, true, due and unpaid, and claimant is entitled to a lien on said premises described and said equipment, and I, J. S. Stafford, hereby claim a lien for such labor done and performed, on and against the said lease and leasehold estate, and against all casing, tools, piping, engines, derricks, rigs, machinery and all equipment located on said premises described; and also on all oil and gas well is located on said premises, and on the run of oil and gas from said wells, whether located on the premises or in the pipelines leading therefrom; and upon all equipment of any and every kind and character, and all personal property located on said premises or connected with the exploring and operating of the said lease and leasehold and said lien is claimed against the said Tipton Petroleum Company, and also the Shepherd Petroleum Company, as owners thereof.

And claimant further says that the last of the labor done and performed on said premises described under the said contract was done on the 15th, day of January, 1923.
