OIL AND GAS MINING LEASE UPON LAND SELECTED FOR ALLOTMENT

CHEROKEE NATION, OKLAHOMA

THIS INDENTURE OF LEASE, made and entered into in quadruplicate on this 10th day of April A. D. 1923, by and between Looney R. Gourd, and Lucinda R. Gourd, his wife, said Looney R. Gourd being of Hulbert, Oklahoma, enrolled as a full blood citizen of the Cherokee Nation, Roll No. 21382, party of the first part, hereinafter designated as lessor, and Eastern Oil Company, a corporation, of Buffalo, New York, party of the second part, hereinafter designated as lessee, under and in pursuance of the provisions of the Act of Congress approved May 27, 1908, (35 Stat. L. P. 312) WITNESSETH:

L. The lessor, for and in consideration of one dollar, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, and of the royalties, covenants, stipulations and conditions hereinafter contained, and hereby agreed to be paid, observed and performed by the lessee, does hereby demise, grant, lease, and let unto the lessee, for the term of ten years from the date of the
