GENERAL WARRANTY DEED

(CORPORATION FORM)

COMPARED

This Indenture, Made this 5th day of June A. D. 1923, between Woodward Park Addition Company a corporation, organized under the laws of the State of Oklahoma of Tulsa County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, party of the first part, and Hazel J. Chapin party of the second part.

WITNESSETH, That in consideration of the sum of Six Hundred Seventy DOLLARS, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, said party of the first part, does, by these presents grant, bargain, sell, and convey unto said party of the second part her heirs, executors or administrators, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lot Seven (7) block six (6) of Woodward Park Addition to the

City of Tulsa, County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, according

the recorded plat thereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said Woodward Park Addition Company, a corporation its successors or assigns, does hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part at the delivery of these presents that it is lawfully seized in its own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance in fee simple, of and in all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, and discharged and unincumbered of and from all former and other grants, titles, charges, estates, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of whatsoever nature and kind. EXCEPT general and special taxes for the year 1919 and subsequent years, and it is further agreed between the parties hereto that this lot is sold for residence purposes only and no dwelling shall be erected thereon to cost less than three thousand Dollars (3000.00) when completed no part of which shall be nearer the front lot line than twenty five feet (25') and that said Corporation will WARRANT and FOREVER DEFEND the same unto said party of the second part her heirs, executors or administrators, against said party of the first part, their successors or assigns, and all and every person or persons whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
