AFFIDAVIT OF RELEASE

Whereas, Allied Refining Company did on the 6th day of March, 1920, promise and agree to pay to the order of the Standard Tank Car Company, successor to Standard Car Construction Company, the sum of Fifty-eight thousand six dollars and forty-four cents (\$58,006.44) evidenced by certain thirty-six (36) of the Corporate notes of the said Allied Refining Company having a total aggregate principal sum of fifty-eight thousand six dollars and forty-four cents (\$58,006.44); the first note due July 1, 1920 and one thereof maturing on the 1st day of each consecutive month thereafter until June 1st, 1923 and

Whereas, in order to secure payment of said notes, and each of them, a lien was reserved by the said Standard Tank Car Company, the Vendor in a certain "Vendor's Lien" or "Car Trust Agreement" executed by the said Standard Tank Car Company as Vendor, and the said Allied Refining Company as Vendee, whereby said Vendor sold and transferred unto said Vendee Twenty-five (25) certain Tank cars, each having a capacity of 8,050 gallons; and

Whereas, in said Vendor's Lien Agreement, a Lien was expressly reserved to secure the payment of aforesaid thirty-six (36) notes aggregating fifty-eight thousand six dollars and forty-four cents (\$58,006.44) as aforesaid.

Now, therefore, this is to certify that each and every of the aforesaid notes have been duly cancelled and the Standard Tank Car Company, the owner and holder of said notes, successors to the Standard Car Construction Company, certifies that the said notes have been properly cancelled and returned to the said Allied Refining Company, the maker.
