NOW, THEREFORE, I, the undersigned, Principal Chief of the Cherokee Nation, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by aforesaid act of the Congress of the United States, have granted and conveyed, and by these presents do grant and convey unto the said Gracie Crossland, all right, title and interest of the Cherokee Nation, and of all other citizens of said nation, in and to the following described land, viz: The South West Ten (10) Acres of Lot Four (4) of Section One (1), Township Twenty Two (22) North and Range Thirteen (13) East and the North Half of the North East quarter of the North East quarter and the South East quarter of the North East quarter of the North East quarter of Section Thirty-five (35) and the North East quarter of the South West Quarter of the South West quarter of Section Fourteen (14), Township Twenty-six (26) North and Range Twenty-one (21) East, and the North West quarter of the North West quarter of the North East quarter of Section Seven (7), Township Twenty (20) North and Range Twenty five (25) East of the Indian base and meridian, in Indian Territory, containing Sixty (60) acres, more or less, as the case may be, according to the United States survey thereof, subject, however, to all the provisions of said act of Congress.
