THIS INDENTURE OF LEASE, Made and entered into in quadruplicate on this 2nd day of August A. D. 1922, by and between Buck Grayson, Ollie Grayson, and J. D. Walker, guardian of Mary Grayson and Neah Grayson, Minors, heirs of Menene Grayson, deceased, of Broken Arrow, Oklahoma, enrolled as a full blood citizen of the Creek Nation, Roll No. 7301, party of the First Part., hereinafter designated as lessor, and James J. Schock of Okmulgee, Oklahoma, party of the second part, hereinafter designated as lessee, under and in pursuance of the provisions of the Act of Congress approved May 27, 1908, (35 Stat. L. P. 312) WITNESSETH:

1. The lessor, for and in consideration of one dollar, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, and of the royalties covenants, stipulations and conditions hereinafter contained,

and hereby agreed to be paid, observed and performed by the lessee, does hereby demise, grant, lease, and let unto the lessee, for the term of ten years from the date of the approval hereof by the Secretary of the Interior, and as much longer thereafter as oil or gas is found in paying quantities, all the oil deposits and natural gas in or under the following described tract of land, lying and being within the county of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit: The Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 26, Township 18 N, Range 13 E of the Indian Meridian, and containing 160 acres, more or less, with the exclusive right to prospect for, extract, pipe, store and remove oil and natural gas, and to occupy and use so much, only of the surface of said land as may reasonably be necessary to carry on the work of prospecting for, extracting, piping, storing, and removing such oil and natural gas, also the right to obtain from wells or other sources on said land by means of pipe lines or otherwise, a sufficient supply of water to carry on said operations, and also the right to use, free of cost, oil and natural gas as fuel so far as necessary to the development and operation of said property.

2. The lessee hereby agrees to pay or cause to be paid to the Superintendent of the Five Civilized Tribes, Muskogee, Oklahoma, for the lessor, as royalty, the sum of 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ per
