East Half of the Southeast quarter of Sec. 19, Twp. 21 N. Range 14 East and that as such heirs, all legal and equitable rights in and to the above described property was and is vested in John T. Hosmer and Etta Hosmer.

Therefore it is ordered, adjudged and decreed that John T. Hosmer and Etta Hosmer, his wife, are the sole and only heirs of the said Zoue Dell Hosmer, deceased.
