

234694 C.J. COMPARED RIGHT OF WAY AGREEMENT

For and in consideration of the sum of Twenty & 25/100 Dollars to him in hand paid by F. Weidner, Supt., THE RECEIPT OF WHICH IS HEREBY ACKNOWLEDGED, John H. Baker does hereby grant to the Tulsa Fuel & Mfg. Co, its successors or grantees, the right of way to lay, maintain, operate, relay and remove a pipe line for the transportation of Gas, with the right of ingress and egress thereto, said right of way being more fully described by definite plat of location attached, situated in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, and on, over and through the following described land:

East-Half of Southeast quarter of Section Nine, Township 21, Range 13, East of the Indian Base and Meridian,

The said grantor, his heirs or grantees, and the public, are to fully use and enjoy the said premises, except the easement herein before granted,

The said The Tulsa Fuel & Manufacturing Co, for itself and its successors or grantees hereby covenants to bury its line of pipe below plow depth so that the same will not interfere with the use of the premises as aforesaid.

It is further agreed that The Tulsa Fuel & Manufacturing Company, its successors or grantees shall have the right to change the size of its said line of pipe the damage, if any, to crops and surface by reason of such change to be paid by the said grantee, its successors or grantees.
