

#225250 NS WARRANTY DEED RECORD NO. 454

This Indenture, Made this 20th day of April, A. D. 1923, between Dan Pilcher and Mollie E. Pilcher, his wife, of Tulsa, County, in the State of Oklahoma, party of the first part and L.N. Van Antwerp and Louise E. Van Antwerp, party of the second part. Witnesseth: That in consideration of the sum of One Dollar and other good and valuable considerations, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, said parties of the first part do hereby these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said parties of the second part their heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lot Twelve (12), Block Six (6), Pilcher Summit  
Addition to Tulsa, Okla., according to the recorded  
survey and plat thereof.

It is hereby understood and agreed that this property shall be used for residence purposes only, and that same shall be erected and remain at least thirty feet from the front property line, said residence to cost not less than Four Thousand Dollars.

To Have and To Hold the Same, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining, forever.

And said Dan Pilcher and Mollie E. Pilcher, for themselves and their heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said parties of the second part that at the delivery of these presents that they are lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance in fee simple, of and in all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear and discharged and unincumbered of and from all former and other grants, titles, charges, estates, judgments, taxes and assessments and incumbrances of whatsoever nature and kind, EXCEPT.

and that they will warrant and forever defend the same unto the said parties of the second part their heirs and assigns against said parties of the first part their heirs and assigns, and all and every person or persons whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
