## WARRANTY DEED RECORD NO. 454

This Indenture, Made this 21st day of April, A. D. 1925, between  
D.C. Powers and Eleanor F. Powers, his wife,  
of Tulsa, County, in the State of Oklahoma, party of the first part and  
H.M. Cosgrove, party of the second part.  
Witnesseth: That in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other good and valuable  
considerations, - - - - - DOLLARS,  
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, said parties of the first part do hereby by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said party  
of the second part his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lot Six (6) in Block Two (2), Lorraine Drive Addition, to  
the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, according to the recorded plat  
thereof.

As a part of the consideration herein designated, it is provided that no  
house other than a dwelling and appurtenances thereto shall be built on  
said lot which shall cost not less than Twenty-Five Hundred (\$2500.00)  
Dollars, Except a small building for temporary residence may be built  
on the rear of said lot. Upon any violation of this restriction, the  
said property hereinabove described shall revert to the party of the  
first part.

presents that they are lawfully seized in their  
own right of an absolute and indefensible estate of inheritance in fee simple, of and in all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the  
appurtenances; that the same are free, clear and discharged and unincumbered of and from all former and other grants, titles, charges, estates, judgments,  
taxes and assessments and incumbrances of whatsoever nature and kind, EXCEPT

Taxes for the year 1921 and thereafter.

and that they will warrant and forever defend the same unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns  
against said party of the first part their heirs and assigns, and all and every person or persons whomsoever, lawfully claiming  
or to claim the same.
