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WARRANTY DEED RECORD NO. 454

Witnesseth: That in consideration of the sum of One Dollar and other considerations

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, said part ~~1st~~ of the first part do ----- by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said part 1st
of the second part her heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lots Thirty-Five (35) and Thirty-Six (36) in Block Four
(4) Orchard Addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma,
according to the recorded plat thereof.

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To Have and To Hold the Same, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise
appertaining, forever.

And said William S. Langston and Louella Langston, their
heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part 1st of the second part that at the delivery of these
presents that they are lawfully seized in their
own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance in fee simple, of and in all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the
appurtenances; that the same are free, clear and discharged and unincumbered of and from all former and other grants, titles, charges, estates, judgments,
