To Have and To Hold the Same, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise
appertaining, forever.

And said Party of the first part and her
heirs, executors or administrators, do SS hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part Y of the second part that at the delivery of these
presents that she lawfully seized in her
own right of an absolute and indefensible estate of inheritance in fee simple, of and in all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the
appurtenances; that the same are free, clear and discharged and unincumbered of and from all former and other grants, titles, charges, estates, judgments,
taxes and assessments and incumbrances of whatsoever nature and kind, EXCEPT.

A first mortgage to the Tulsa Building & Loan Co. for the amount of
Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1500.00) and a second mortgage to Callie
Snow for the amount of Twelve Hundred (\$1200.00) Dollars.

against said part Y of the first part her heirs and assigns, and all and every person or persons whomsoever, lawfully claiming
or to claim the same.
