STIPULATION MODIFYING TERMS OF OIL AND GAS MINING LEASE.

(To be executed in quadruplicate)

Whereas, Eli E. Hardridge and Evaline Bland, nee Martin as lessor and J. I. Carper and Albert T. Patrick, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, as lessee, entered into as an oil and gas mining lease dated September 30, 1915 covering the following described land allotted to Helen Hardridge and situate in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Whereas, the present owner of said lease and the owner of the said described land desire to amend, change and modify certain terms of said contract.

Now, therefore, in consideration of the sum of one (\$1.00) dollar, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the lessor, and other and further valuable considerations, said lease is hereby modified so as to in all respects conform to the terms and conditions of the lease form authorized and adopted in pursuance of the amended regulations approved by the Secretary of the Interior on February 6, and June 29, 1911, a copy of which lease form, marked Exhibit "A", is attached hereto and made apart hereof, and all terms and conditions of said original lease contract in conflict therewith are hereby abrogated and held for naught; Provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall be construed to change the date of said above described lease or the date from which rents and royalties thereunder shall be computed and be payable.
