

Lessee shall have the right to use, free of cost, gas, oil and water produced on said land for its operation thereon, except water from wells of lessor.

When requested by lessor, lessee shall bury its pipe lines below plow depth.

COMPARED No well shall be drilled nearer than 200 feet to the house or barn now on said premises.

Lessee shall pay for damages caused by its operations to growing crops on said land.

Lessee shall have the right at any time to remove all machinery and fixtures placed on said premises, including the right to draw and remove casing.

If the estate of either party hereto assigned - and the privilege of assigning in whole or in part is expressly allowed - the covenants hereof shall extend to the assigns and successive assigns, but no change in ownership of the land or assignment of rentals or royalties shall be binding on the lessee until after the lessee has been furnished with a written transfer or assignment or a true copy thereof.
