DEED OF DEDICATION

Know all men by these presents : That The Prairie Oil & Gas Company, a Corporation, of the State of Kansas, for value received, does hereby give, grant and dedicate to the City of Tulsa, Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, and to the public,

To have and to hold forever, for use as a public street, a parcel of land situated in said City of Tulsa, Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

All that part of lot one (1) in Block one (1) of the Berry addition to City of Tulsa, bounded by a line as follows: Beginning at the northwest corner of said lot; running thence south <sup>on</sup> of the west line of said lot, 76.1 feet to the southwest corner thereof; thence easterly <sup>on</sup> to the south line of said lot 19.9 feet to a point 18.2 feet east of west line of said lot; thence north parallel to West line of said lot a distance of 68.03 feet to a point on the north line of said lot; thence west on north line of said lot a distance of 18.2 feet to place of beginning.
