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COMPARED WARRANTY DEED?

Witnesseth, that the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of two thousand two hundred fifty and 00/100 dollars the receipt whereof is hereby ackowledged, and the further cosideration and as a condition of this deed to which the grantee herein by accepting this deed assents and agrees; that the lot or lots hereby conveyed, shall not with a period of ten years from this date becused for any other than residence hotel purpses; that no store building, /duplex, house, flats of apartments shall be erected thereon during such period; that no residence that shall cost less than eight Inourand dollars (\$8,000.00) shall be built on the lot or lots hereby conveyed; that nne residence only shall be built on said lots; that no building or any part thereof, except steps or entrance approach without roof shall be built or extend within 25 feet of the front lot line or closer than - - - feet of the side street line, and no garage, servant's house of other subsidiary building shall extend within 70 feet of the front lot line or within - - - feet of the side street line; that no part of the lot or lots hereby conveyed shall ever be sold or rented to, or occupied by, any person of African descent known as negries, provided, however, that the building of a servant's house to be used only by servants of the owner or lesse_ of the lot or lots hereby conveyed shall not be considered as a breach of this condition, - - do by these presents grant, barga in, sell and convey unto said party of the second part her heirs and assigns, all the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulse, State of Oklahoma, to-wit: Lot thirty (30) in Block two (2) in Travis Heights addition to the Cityof Tulss, Uklahoma, according to the recorded plat thereof duly recorded in the office of Register of Deeds within and for Tulss County, Oklahoma.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the temements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever. And said M. R. Travis and Rhea Travis, for themselves and for their heirs, executors, or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise shaagree to and with said party of the second part, that at the delivery of these presents they are lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, infee simple, of and in all and singula the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, and discharged and unincumbered of and from all former and other grants, titles, charges, estates, judgements, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what/hature of kind soever, except taxes falling due after this date, and that they will warrant and forever defend the same unto the said party of the second part ther heirs and assigns, against said parties of the first part, their heirs, administrators, assigns and all and every person or persons whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same. All special assessments taxes shall be paid by the party of the second part.
