ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION.

Be it known, that the undersigned citizens of the State of Oklahoma, do hereby voluntarily associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a private corporation under the laws of the State of Oklahoma, and do hereby certify.

FIRST:

That the name of this Corporation shall be

AKDAR CORPORATION.

SECOND:

That the purposes for which this Corporation is formed are:

1: To encourage, morality, impart instruction relative to, and promote the growth of the precepts, tenets and principles of the Ancient Arabic Order of Nobles of the Mystic Shrine of North America among the members of Akdar Temple of Tulsa, Oklahoma; to aid and assist in the progress, growth, stability and permanency of Akdar Temple, and as well to engage and assist in charitable, projects for the benefit of the community generally in the City of Tulsa and elsewhere; Provided, however, nothing herein contained shall be construed so as to permit this corporation or its income or properties to be used or diverted for the pecuniary benefit or profit of any of its members.
