

The county clerk of Okmulgee County, Oklahoma, in book M 186, page 491,

P. A certain oil and gas mining lease executed and delivered on the 9th day of June, 1919, by J. D. Alexander and Nellie Alexander, his wife, to E. R. Byrum, covering a certain tract or parcel of land described by metes and bounds as follows: Beginning at a point 528 feet north and 110 feet east of the southwest corner of the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of section 18, township 19, north, range 6 east, of the I.M. running north 48 rods, thence east 110 feet; thence south 48 rods; thence west 110 feet to the point of beginning, Payne County, Oklahoma. Said lease is recorded in the office of the county clerk of Payne County, Oklahoma, in book 11 LR, page 178.

Q. A certain Departmental oil and gas mining lease executed and delivered on the 14th day of October 1921, by Hokty Dunson, now Byrd, to W. H. Shackelford, and E. E. Dix, insofar as same covers an undivided three-fourths interest in the north half of the northeast quarter of section nineteen (19) township ten (10) north, range ten (10) east, Okfuskee County, Oklahoma, and duly approved by the Secretary of the Interior on the 26th day of November, 1921. This lease is recorded in the office of the county clerk of Okfuskee County, Oklahoma, in book B 61, page 384. Supervision of the Department has heretofore been relinquished over this undivided three-fourths interest.

Q. (1) A certain Departmental oil and gas mining lease executed and delivered on the 4th day of November, 1919, by Dave Hickey, to W. H. Shackelford, insofar as same covers the east half (E $\frac{1}{2}$) of the southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of section 30, township 18 north, range 14 east, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and duly approved by the Secretary of the Interior on April 2, 1920. This lease is recorded in the office of the County clerk of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, in book 279, page 543. Supervision of the Department has heretofore been relinquished over same.

R. An undivided one-sixteenth interest in and to a certain oil and gas mining lease executed and delivered by M. F. Stein, and W. O. Rittenhouse to W. A. Campbell, dated the 22nd day of August 1917, covering the west half of the southeast quarter and the southeast quarter of the northeast quarter and the south half of the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter and the east half of the southeast quarter of the southwest quarter of section twenty nine (29) township nineteen (19) north, range eleven (11) east, and containing 160 acres, more or less, Tulsa County, Oklahoma. This lease is recorded in the office of the County Clerk of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, in book 231, page 221, together with all of the producing wells, whether of oil or gas, or oil and gas, on each of said leases, and all the buildings, casings, pipe, pipe lines tanks, power boilers, engines, automobiles, tractors, and all rigs, and all tools and equipment of every sort and kind of each of said leases.
