The second party, and heirs and assigns, all the right title, interest, estate, claim and demand, of first party, both at law and in equity, in and to all the following described real property, situated in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma to-wit: Lot eleven (11) block five (5) in Clinton's addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, Tulsa County, according to the recorded plat thereof.

(This deed is given to correct an error made in a deed dated Dec. 4th, 1922, by and between Thos. K. Shaw and Lewis C. Yocum, ssid deed being recorded in book 429, page 350, of the Tulsa County, records, Tulsa, Okla), together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging.

To have and to hold the premises above described unto the said second party and heirs and assigns so that neither the said first party nor any person in the name and behalf of such party shall or will hereafter claim or demand any right or title to the said premises or any part thereof, but they, and every one of them, shall by these presents be excluded and forever barred.
