(a) Said premises sold for residents' purposes only, and the minimum cost of any dwelling placed thereon, shall be \$4,000.00 when completed, and no part of suc h dwelling shall be nearer the front line than twenty feet.

Said Trustee, on behalf of those own.ing the beneficial interest in said real estate at the time of the execution of this deod, as is shown in a certain Trust Agreement now of record in the office of the County Clerk, oEx-Officio Register of Deeds, of said County and State, dated the 15th day of November (1919, but not on behalf of itself, covenants and agrees with the party of the second part that the party of the firstpart at the time of delivery of these presents is seized of a good and indefessible title and estate of igheritance in fee simple in and to said real estate and covenants that it is in peaceful and undisputed possession of said presises, with full right and power to convey the same by this instrument to said from all former and other grants, charges, taxes, judgements and other liens ofr incumbrances of whatsoever kind or nature, and hereby binds those having the beneficial interest in said prmises, their heirs and assigns, forever, to observe the covenants and agreements herein contained and to warrant and defend the title to said land, against all claims of every nature.
