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afterwards on the 26th day of May, 1923, an order of sale of that date was issued out of the office of the Court Clerk in pursuance to said jugement and decree, directing the Sheriff of Tusa County, Calahoma, and commanding him to cause the real estate described in said decree being the real estate hereinafter described, to be sold according to law without appraisement, appraisement having been waived, after the expiration of six months from the rendition of said judgement and decree, and further directing said Sheriff to make return of said order of sale according to law, showing the manner in whic said Sheriff had executed said order, the said return to be made within sixty days from the date of said order; and

Whereas, said order of sale was duly delivered to and received by said Sheriff on the said 26th day of May, 1923, and said Sheriff by virtue of the said Court and the said order, did on the 28th day of June, 1923, after advertising said realestate for sale by giving due and legal noticenof the time and place of sale, and a description of the property to be sold, and the terms of the sale, by advertising the same in The Tulsa Daily Legal News, a newspaper of general carculation printed and published in said County, the said notice being published in said paper daily from May 28th, to June 27th, 1923, inclusive.

And, whereas, on the said 28th day of June, 1923, pursuant to said notice the Sheriff did offer said property for sale as advertised, as public auction, at the west front door of the Court House in the City of Tulsa, in said Countym at the hour of 2 o'clock P.M. at which sale the said property was sold and struck off to S. H. Thompson, the purchaser, the grantecherein, for the sum of \$2750.00 the said purchaser being the highest and best bidder and that being the highest sum bid, and the entire price paid for same.

H. Thompson, his heirs and assigns, all the estate, right, title and estate which the said Noco Boulton, now Noco Dunphy, and E. J. Dunphy, her hysband, had at the time to the said Noco Boulton executed the mortgage foreclosed by the plaintiff in the above entitled action, and also such title as the said Noco Boulton, now Noco Dunphy and F. J. Dunphy had at the tike of the jugement of foreclosure on the 25th day of November, 1922, or at any time thereafter or now has of, in and to the following described premises situated in said County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, described as follows The north half of the southwest quarter and the south half of the northwest to-wit: quarter of section nine (9) township seventeen (17) north, range fourteen (14) east, containing 160 acres, more or less, together with all and singulat the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining.

To have and to hold the said premises, with the appurtenances, unto the said S. H.
