**CEMETERY LOT DEED.**

This indenture, made and entered into this 20th day of August, 1910 by and between The Collinsville Cemetery Improvement Association, duly incorporated, under the laws of the State of Oklahoma, party of the first part, and W. L. Wright, party of the second part.

Witnesseth, that the party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of old deed, - dollars -, to it in hand paidm the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the said Collinsville Cemetery Improvement Association hereby grants, bargains, sells and quit claims unto the said party of the second part, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever, in fee simple, Lot No. 9, in Block No. 4, as marked and designated on the recorded plat of the cemetery grounds located in and being a part of the northwest quarter of Section Thirty (30) township twenty two (22) north, range fourteen (14) east.

To have and to hold the same unto the same W. L. Wright, with all the improvements thereon or in any way appertaining to the same.

The said party of the first part hereby covenants with the party of the second part that it has a lawful right to sell and convey the same for burial purposes only; that the said described lots have been set aside for burial purposes, and the party of the first part hereby reserves the right to make all necessary rules and regulations governing the burial of the dead on the said described lots, and it is agreed that the said party will conform to any and all such rules and regulations so made or may hereafter be made by the said party of the first part, in so far as they appertain to the burial of the dead or any improvements on said lot or any decoration of any grave or graves on said property.

In witness whereof, the said Collinsville Cemetery Improvement Association has caused its corporate seal to be hereto affixed, and attested by its Secretary, and these presents signed, acknowledged and delivered in its name and behalf by its duly authorized President, the day and date first above mentioned.
