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RELEASE OF OIL AND GAS LEASE.

COMPARED

Dated May 12, 1923.

Whereas, a certain oil and gas mining lease dated June 16 1922, given by S. R. Lewis, lessor to C. R. Hunter, lessee covering the following described land, situate in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:
