## RELEASE OF MORTGAGE.

 Oklahoma County ) Whereas, on the 14th day of September, 1917, Annie B. Gibson and Kelly F. Gibson, wife and husband, of Broken Arrow, Oklahoma, made, executed and delivered to the Commissioners of the Land Office of the State of Oklahoma, for the use and benefit of the State of Oklahoma, one certain note for the sum of: Forty five hundred and no/100 (\$4500.00) dollars, secured by a real estate mortgage on all of the following described real property situated in Tulsa County, to-wit:

The south half of the northeast quarter and all of the southeast quarter of section 35, twp. 19 N, range 14 E, I.B. and M, containing 240 acres, more or less as the case may be, according to the U.S. Survey thereof

This mortgage being recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, on the 12th day of October, 1917, at 11:20 o'clock, A.M. in book 224, page 585, of mortgages.

Whereas, at the regular meeting of the Commissioners of the Land Office of the State of Oklahoma held June 17th, 1913, the following resolution was adopted:

"Be it resolved, that the Secretary to the Commissioners of the Land Office of the State of Oklahoma, be and he is hereby authorized to accept payment of any mortgage and the debt secured thereby made to the Commissioner of the Land Office of the State of Oklahoma, and upon <sup>such</sup> payment having been made, the Chairman and the Secretary to the Commissioners of the Land Office of the State of Oklahoma, on behalf of the Commissioners be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to execute good and sufficient release to the proper parties there fore. "

All vote "Aye". Motion prevailed.

Whereas, payment in full having been made on said note.

Now, therefore, under and by virtue of the above resolution, the Commissioners of the Land Office by their Chairman and Secretary for and on behalf of the State of Oklahoma, in consideration of value received, do hereby acknowledge full payment and complete satisfaction of the mortgage above described, and do hereby release and discharge said land from the lien of said mortgage.
