Provided, always, that this instrument is made, executed and delivered upon the following conditions, to-wit: That said first part ies hereby
 covenant and agree to pay all taxes and assessments of said land when the same shall become due, and to keep all improvements in good repair
 and not to commit or allow waste to be committed upon the premises, and to insure, and keep insured in favor of second
 party, buildings on said premises.

It is further expressly agreed by and between the parties hereto that if any default be made in the payment of the principal sum of this mort-
