This mortgage is given to secure the principal sum of Twenty-Three Hundred Seventy-nine and 75/100 (\$2379.75) DOLLARS,
 with interest thereon at the rate of eight per cent, per annum, payable annually from Sixty-five
 according to the terms of S certain promissory note S described as follows, to-wit:

Sixty-four (64) notes dated April 9th, 1921 in denominations of \$36.81 each, payable on or before maturity. First note being numbered #26 due June 9th, 1923 and one note due each succeeding month thereafter, said notes bearing 8% interest from date, payable at maturity, and one note in the amount of \$23.91 of like description.

Provided, always, that this instrument is made, executed and delivered upon the following conditions, to-wit: That said first part ies hereby covenant and agree to pay all taxes and assessments of said land when the same shall become due, and to keep all improvements in good repair and not to commit or allow waste to be committed upon the premises.

It is further expressly agreed by and between the parties hereto that if any default be made in the payment of the principal sum of this mortgage or any interest installment, or the taxes, insurance premiums, or in case of the breach of any covenant herein contained, the whole of said principal sum, with interest, shall be due and payable, and this mortgage may be foreclosed and the second part ies shall be entitled to the immediate possession of the premises and all the rents and profits thereof.

Said part ies of the first part hereby agree, that in the event action is brought to foreclose this mortgage, ies will pay a reasonable attorney's fee of 10% of the unpaid balance DOLLARS which this mortgage also secures.

Part ies of the first part, for said consideration, do hereby expressly waive appraisalment of said real estate and all benefit of the homestead, exemption and stay laws in Oklahoma.
