Now, Therefore, I, under the authority vested in me by the Act of Congress approved May 29, 1908, (35 Stat.L.444), and the regulations prescribed thereunder, hereby remove the restrictions from said above described land except that such removal shall not relate to or affect mineral lying on or being under the above described land, such removal of restrictions to become effective only and simultaneously with the execution of deed by said allottee to School District No. 19, Tulsa County, Oklahoma.
