 between the parties hereto that in the event the property, lands or monies, or any part  
 thereof, shall be recovered, the said party of the second part shall be entitled to, and  
 shall receive one-half of the same as full compensation for such services, and the party of  
 the first part hereby agrees and binds himself or assigns to set over and deliver by proper  
 conveyances to the said party of the second part, his heirs or assigns one-half of all  
 property, monies or lands recovered.

This contract and agreements shall be binding on the heirs, assigns executors, admin-  
 istrators or legal representatives of all parties hereto.

AGREEMENT

COMPARED

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this 19 day of August 1922, by and between Martha  
 Washington of Okmulgee Okla., party of the first part, and J. V. Bourland and Cochran and  
 Rattenee, party of the second part,

WITNESSETH, That for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar in hand paid, the re-  
 ceipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and other good and valuable considerations, the party  
 of the first part hereby employs the party of the second party to recover the following des-  
 cribed lands situate in the County of Tulsa, Oklahoma, to-wit:

The undivided half interest of the South East Quarter of  
 Section 18, township 19 Range 14 East

together with all property or monies in connection therewith, and the party of the second  
 part agrees to undertake to recover the said lands, property or monies, and employ counsel  
 when the same becomes necessary in the prosecution of any suits necessary in said under-
