Myers of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, all that vertain piece, parcel or tract of land lying and being situated in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and being Lot #74 in Fairview Section, containing 300 square feet, be the same more or less out of ROSE HILL BURIAL PARKas more fully appears from may of said Burial Park hereby referred to and made a part hereof.

It is expressly agreed and understood that this conveyance is made subject to the pre visions and restrictions specified in the Rules and Regulations of said Burial Park at the present time, and which are made a part of this conveyance, or which said Buriel Park may hereafter make in conformity with the laws of the State of Oklahoma.
