## ASSIGNMENT OF OIL AND GAS LEASE COMPARED

Now therefore in consideration of the sum of One Dollar, and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the said Hugo Drilling Company does hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey, transfer, and assign, to the Sac and Fox Oil Company, a corporation, of Chandler, Oklahoma, all of its right, title interest, estate or claim therein or thereto, as the same may appear of record, together with all the personal property used or obtained in connection therewith, to have and to hold the same to the said Sac and Fox Oil Company, its successors and assigns, forever.

And for the same consideration the undersigned for themselves their heirs, successors and representatives do covenant with the assignee, its successors and assigns, that they (the grantors) herein are the lawful owners of the said leases, and the rights thereunder and of the personal property thereon or used in connection therewith. That the undersigned have good right and authority to sell and convey the same, and said rights and interest and property are free and clear from all liens and incumbrances, and that all rentals and royalties due and payable thereunder have been duly paid.
