PETITION FOR THE APPROVAL OF DEED OF ANNA T. ADAMS TO ETHEL DAVIS

Comes now your petitioner, Anna T. Adams, and represents to this Honorable Court: That she is a full blood Creek Indian enrolled upon the final citizenship rolls of the Creek Nation opposite roll Number 5424; That she is the wife of Samuel Adams, deceased;

That the said Samuel Adams was a full blood creek Indian enrolled upon the final citizenship rolls of the Creek Nation opposite roll number 6957; That as such citizen of the Creek National of Indians, there was allotted to the said Samuel Adams by the commission to the Five Civilized Tribes the following described real estate:

The South $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 2,
Township 19 North, Range 11 East, T.B.M. situate and lying
in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, containing 120 Acres more or
less as the case may be

according to the United States plat and survey thereof, the same being a portion of the Individual allotment of Samuel Adams, deceased.

That Samuel Adams died intestate in Creek County, State of Oklahoma, on or about the 13th day of February, 1911, A.D., and left surviving him as his sole and only heirs at law your petitioner, Anna T. Adams, who was the lawful wife and Jim Adams an infant son of the age of about seven month; That Jim Adams, the infant son of Samuel Adams, deceased, died on
