Adams, as the wife of the said Samuel Adams, deceased, inherited an undivided one half interest in and to the foregoing described land and that under the laws of descent and distribution of the State of Oklahoma and under the laws of the United States relative to Creek Indian descent your petitioner inherits said land and that under the law she also inherits the other undivided one-half interest of her son, Jim Adams which descends to him immediately upon the death of his father, and has a legal right to transfer, sell or convey the same by deed;

That on the 21st day of February, 1911, A.D., your petitioner Anna T. Adams, did by her certain warranty deed for and in consideration of the sum of Twelve Hundred Dollars (\$1200.00) conveyed all of her right, title and interest in and to the South $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ all in Section 2, Township 19 North Range 11 East, I.B.M. containing 120 acres all in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, to Ethel Davis;

That she has received as a portion of the consideration Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) in cash which was paid to her by the said Ethel Davis, on the 21st day of February, 1911, A.D., the remaining Seven Hundred (\$700.) to be delivered as this Honorable Court may direct either to the Court or to the said Anna T. Adams;

That the consideration mentioned herein is ample and sufficient; That the said deed was fairly made and legally executed; That she is satisfied with said sale and deed of conveyance and made the same with full knowledge of all her right and interest.

WHEREFORE your petitioner prays that the deed made to Ethel Davis be by this Court ratified, confirmed, approved and declared valid and will ever pray.
