

That the said Theodore Potts and Edna Potts, defendants herein, are residents of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma,

COMPARED

That service of summons in this cause was had upon the said defendant Edna Potts by personal service in Tulsa County on the 9th day of May, 1923, and that service was had upon the said defendant Theodore Potts in said County of Tulsa, by leaving a copy of said summons with a member of his family over sixteen years of age at his usual place of residence in said County of Tulsa, Oklahoma, on the 9th day of May, 1923, by John B. Jury, Marshall by N? Martin, Deputy

The court further finds that the said plaintiff herein, J. S. Sepslin, did sell and deliver to said defendants, certain goods, wares, and merchandise of the value of Seventy-three (\$73.00) Dollars; that said sale was made by said plaintiff to said defendants under and by virtue of a certain contract in writing

The court further finds that default was made in the payment of said goods, wares and merchandise, by said defendants to said plaintiff.

The court further finds that there is now due and owing from the said Theodore Potts and said Edna Potts, defendants to the said J. S. Sepslin, plaintiff, the sum of Seventy-three (\$73.00) Dollars, with interest at six per cent per annum from the 15th day of July, 1921.

The court further finds that the Grinnell Heating & Plumbing Company were served as garnishee in said cause and have filed their answer herein admitting indebtedness to said defendant Theodore Potts in the sum of Five and 50/100 (\$5.50) Dollars.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the said plaintiff J. S. Sepslin have and recover judgment against the said Theodore Potts and Edna Potts and each of them in the sum of Eighty-one and 35/100 (\$81.35) Dollars with interest at six per cent per annum from date hereof.

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that the garnishee, Grinnell Heating & Plumbing Company of Tulsa, Oklahoma, pay into this court, the sum of Five and 50/100 (\$5.50) Dollars, being the amount due from said garnishee to said Defendant Theodore Potts, at the time of the service of said garnishment, and it is ordered that judgment entered against said garnishee, Grinnell Heating & Plumbing Company, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, for Five and 50/100 and six per cent interest per annum from date hereof, and when paid into said court shall be applied upon said judgment, attorneys fee and cost.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the plaintiff have judgment against said defendants, Theodore Potts and Edna Potts and each of them for the cost of this action.

RELEASE OF MORTGAGE

COMPARED
