RELEASE OF MORTGAGE

WHEREAS, on the 28th day of January 1916, Willis H. Booth and W. H. Booth, one and the same person, a widower, of Broken Arrow, Oklahoma, made, executed and delivered to the Commissioners of the Land Office of the State of Oklahoma, for the use and benefit of the State of Oklahoma, one certain note for the sum of: TWO THOUSAND and NO/100 (\$2000.00) DOLLARS, secured by a real estate mortgage on all of the following described real property situated in Tulsa County, to-wit:

The South Half of the Southeast Quarter; Northwest Quarter
of Sotheast Quarter of Sec. 21, Twp 18 North, Range 14 E. I.M. c
containing 120 acres.

This mortgage being recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, on the 10th day of February 1916, at 3:30 o'clock P.M. in book 186 page 486 of mortgages.

WHEREAS, at the regular meeting of the Commissioners of the Land Office of the State of Oklahoma, held June 17th 1913, the following resolution was adopted:

"Be it resolved, that the Secretary of the Commissioners of the Land Office of the State of Oklahoma, be and he is hereby authorized to accept payment of any mortgage and the debt secured thereby made to the Commissioners of the Land Office of the State of Oklahoma, and upon such payment having been made, the chairman and the Secretary of the Commissioners of the Land Office of the State of Oklahoma, on behalf of the Commissioners be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to execute good and sufficient release to the proper parties there fore."

All vote "AYE". MOTION prevailed.

WHEREAS, Payment in full having been made on said note.

NOWTHEREFORE, Under and by virtue of the above resolution, the Commissioners of the Land Office by their chairman and Secretary for and on behalf of the State of Oklahoma, in consideration of value received, do hereby acknowledged full payment and complete satisfaction of the mortgage above described, and do hereby release and discharge said land from the lien of said mortgage.
